ANNUAL PLAN FOR CLASSES I TO XII

1. Life skill oriented CCE activities chapter wise for all subjects.
2. Value based integrated learning of the chapters and the feedback of the same recorded.
3. Co-Curricular Activities scheduled and conducted for the academic session to facilitate the child to identify his/her talents.
4. Child's experience of the day, shared with the class/Teacher on a day to day basis.
5. Achiever's Desk in the classroom as a mode of appreciation when a child shows progress in his/her behavior and academic approach.
6. House display boards, Chart display boards class wise to reflect the child's response.
7. Hobby classes after school hours in order to cater to the child's interest.
8. PTM conducted every month to discuss and record the child's progress.
9. The counselor in the school deals with emotional problems of the students in order to motivate and overcome challenges.
10. Counseling sessions and awareness sessions are conducted regularly to sensitize the child with the surrounding.
11. Orientation meet was organized in the month of July 2014 to enlighten the parents of class I to XII.
12. Interactive session with OTA Cadets was conducted to motivate the children constructively.
13. The students are exposed with their visit to Passing-out parade, Fire power display by OTA.
14. Focus on Thematic Assembly, School Magazine, participating in Inter school competitions are various other activities to improve the interest and involvement of the learners.
